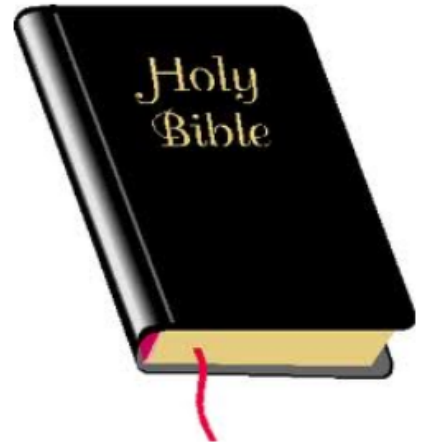

# Current vs. Default
